Inchmahome Island in the centre of the lake is a popular tourist destination, upon which the ancient Inchmahome Abbey ruins are to be found, where allegedly young Mary Queen of Scots once sought refuge. This is a dog friendly establishment, and a perfect location for countryside walks.
